(Valhalla, NY) – Two hundred (200) CAREERS' clients, their employers and guests attended the Annual Anniversary Celebration of CAREERS for People with Disabilities, Inc. So far this year despite a still difficult economy, our job placements are up 27% over last year, and we have helped the majority of our clients avoid layoffs and retain their employment," said Tina Cornish-Lauria, Executive Director of CAREERS.
