From golf outings to fundraising campaigns, Ms. Tucker generated hundreds of thousands of dollars for area non-profit organizations, including the American Cancer Society, The Emelin Theatre and St. Peter's Day Care Center in Peekskill.

Ms. Tucker was honored by the Andrus Children's Center with their "Best for Westchester Award" in 2010. She was also the Women in Communications Matrix Award winner
