The event's keynote speaker was Danielle Spencer, an actress and a child star in ABC's hit comedy "What's Happening, who became disabled in 1994 when a lower back condition required her to use a wheelchair. Charlie North, President of the Dutchess Regional Chamber of Commerce emceed the event, which was attended by approximately 150 people.
