Over the past few years we have continued to receive less money for our programs, which means that each year we need to fundraise more and more. This year alone, we need to raise approximately \$150,000 just to meet our budget, which we've kept at the same level — without any salary or cost-of-living increases for the staff — for the fourth year in a row.

Because 85% of our funding comes from state and local government, the recent recession and governmental cutbacks have hit us hard. Some facts:

- Medicaid recently cut our funding by 2%, retroactive to April of last year.
- Only 13% of our revenue pays for general and administrative costs.
- Only 2% of our revenue is spent on fundraising.
- Most of our contracts do not pay for administrative costs – we must pay for those costs by fundraising.
- 85% of our revenue goes directly towards paying for job training, placement and support.
- On average, we provide services to 450 individuals with disabilities each year.
- In 2011, we placed 97 people in jobs – a 29% increase over the previous year – despite the high unemployment rate throughout Westchester and Putnam Counties.
- Over the past 3 years we have helped record numbers of clients retain their jobs at record levels, despite an increase in the unemployment rate among the non-disabled population.
- Since 1988, we have helped over 2,000 individuals find jobs and provided services to well over 6,000 people.

Individual contributions are the most important source of our fundraising — especially with the recent decreases in government funding. As we celebrate our 25th year, we need your continued help and support to assure that we continue to place, and maintain, people with disabilities in jobs throughout Westchester and Putnam Counties.

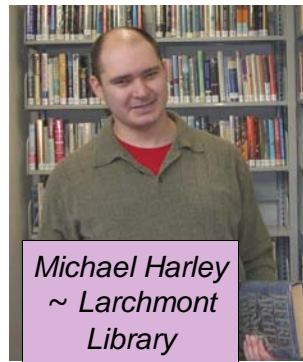
