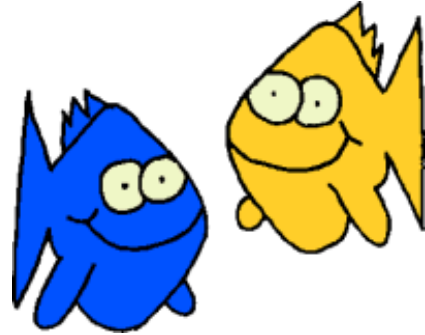


Teach Me to Fish . . . Work Skills for Life
