Two dozen community leaders met to build collaboration and consensus to enhance accessible transportation throughout the county. Transportation is a matter that affects all people, but is especially important for people with disabilities, who often cannot access usual transportation resources, and may thereby be forced into a terrible social isolation. Putnam County is one of ten communities selected from a nationwide competition to participate in a one-year systems change process to improve transportation options for people with disabilities.
