CAREERS Support Solutions: New Name, Same Mission



CAREERS for People with Disabilities has a new name, yet the non-profit now called CAREERS Support Solutions continues to provide job training and placement, in addition to ongoing support for individuals with disabilities, just as it has for the past 30 years.

Located on Fair Street in Carmel across from Carmel High School, CAREERS has made more than 2,500 job placements while providing support services to some 6,000 individuals since 1987.

CAREERS executive director Tina Cornish-Lauria said last year her organization placed 115 men and women in new jobs and more than 40 others in internships: "Our professional staff provides personalized support to our clients as well as personnel solutions to our employers. Our new name highlights this winwin relationship."
